The Branch has a new heating boiler! After 32vrs of dedicated service, our old heating boiler struggled thru January. We had hoped to coach it through till the spring. In anticipation of this replacement, we had applied for a Ontario Trillium Foundation Grant which we were successful obtaining in December 2022. Sadly, the boiler during the Feb cold snap really started to act up and had our Property & Housing Chair visit the Branch several times to relight or tweak the boiler to keep it working. We had to move ahead with the install and just in time, as even the contractor was amazed it was still working! Because we had to install before our Branch Notice Of **Motion** was completed, an email or letter has now been sent to all members to follow through with the Legion Provincial Regulations on a Branch repair or renovation of over \$25,000.

Thankyou to Dave Tempeny and our contractor Rocque Mechanical for the one day and done installation. Few folks even knew the boiler was being exchanged on Thursday 9 Feb, as there was no room temperature drop.
